Terms on which the premium is allocated to schools

The premium must be spent by schools on making additional and sustainable improvements to the provision of PE and sport for the benefit of all pupils to encourage the development of healthy, active lifestyles.

The Secretary of State does not consider the following expenditure as falling within the scope of additional or sustainable improvement:

- employing coaches or specialist teachers to cover - these should come out of schools' core staffing budgets
- teaching the minimum requirements of the national curriculum PE programmes of study - including those specified for swimming

Maintained schools must publish, on their website, information about their use of the PE and Sport Grant. Schools should publish the amount of grant received; how it has been spent (or will be spent) and what impact the school has seen on pupils' PE and sport participation and attainment as a result, to help to ensure that all pupils develop healthy lifestyles.

Certification Requirements - Local authorities will be required to certify that they have passed on the correct amount of funding to schools and, where funding has been spent, confirmation from each maintained school that it has been spent in line with the conditions of grant.
